

### Bachelor's Degrees - "First cycle"

The Italian 'Laurea Triennale / corso di laurea di primo livello / diploma accademico di primo livello' ("First level academic degree") is equivalent to a standard Bachelor's Degree, as it has been certified by the Senate of the City of Berlin. It has the stated aim of guaranteeing to students a sufficient command of artistic methods, techniques and concepts towards the acquisition of specific professional competences.

As such, <u>all formal requirements</u> and documents are stipulated, regulated and in part handled via the Italian Ministry of Education. This includes formal application and registration procedures, course accreditation and examination procedures, and finally the issue of all Degree Documents such as the Bachelor's Degree Certificate. Applicants are thus required to present a translation of their high school certificate that has also been certified by the Italian Consulate. Successful Graduates will be accordingly issued Italian "Laurea Triennale / Corso die Laurea die Primo Livello" Graduation Certificates. # Admission requirements:

The requirement for admission to first cycle degree (laurea triennale/corso di laurea di primo livello) a Bachelor's Degree Course is the diploma awarded at the end of secondary school. Students are admitted if they have a high school diploma or another qualification taken abroad and recognized in Italy. The minimum requirement is the "Diploma di Maturità" (at least 12 years) or an equivalent foreign qualification; admission furthermore depends on passing entry tests designed to verify a sufficient initial competence.

The final diploma of secondary studies "Diploma di Maturità" (at least 12 years) – high school - should be accompanied by a translation into the Italian language, officially legalized by the Italian competent Consulate.

## The Bachelor's Course Level is officially defined by the following criteria:

Classification: Bologna process first cycle qualification/EQF level 6

Workload: 180 ECTS Duration: 3 years
